

Feasibility Study : Proposed Community Purchase Of Land In And Around Wanlockhead

Village/Community Amenities and Services

The previous community consultation highlighted a number of potential improvements to local amenities and services.

Some comments suggested the overall village appearance should be improved. Poor landscaping, unsightly fencing, land subsidence and the untidy appearance of some buildings were the main issues mentioned. Better village services were also suggested such as a shop, improved roads, and faster broadband.

A number of people suggested there should be more resources for children and young people. For example, the playpark could be upgraded and new facilities such as an indoor soft playpark, football pitch, youth centre and sport centre could be considered in future development plans.

Additionally old areas used in the past for curling and bowls could be brought back into use.
